Missile Defense Agency Engineering & Support Services (MiDAESS) Contract

Colorado Springs, Co. – July 1, 2010 – Keta Group, LLC (“Keta”) announced today that its wholly-owned subsidiary, Colorado Professional Resources, LLC (“CP Resources”), is part of a team that has been awarded an indefinite-delivery, indefinite-quantity contract to provide advisory and assistance support services to the nation’s ballistic missile defense program.

Under the five-year contract, 3 teams will compete for up to \$565 million of individual tasks involving infrastructure and deployment needs of various agencies supporting the Ballistic Missile Defense System. Work will be performed in Huntsville, Ala.; Colorado Springs, Colo.; and other Missile Defense Agency locations.

CP Resources was formed in 2008 by the Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana as a wholly owned subsidiary of Keta to provide professional services in support of Department of Defense Agencies. Prior to that time, CP Resources was a division within Keta.

The primary purpose of the Keta family of companies is to diversify and bolster the economy of the Chitimacha Tribe and provide opportunities and benefits to its members, approximately 1,000 people, by capitalizing on opportunities in the federal contracting market. The product and service offerings of the Keta Group family of companies are focused on disaster recovery services, space and defense engineering services, information technology services, construction, and facility management services associated with facility and base operations support. Keta’s corporate headquarters are located in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, and Keta has subsidiary and project offices in Colorado Springs, Colorado; Washington, D.C.; Schriever AFB, Colorado; Peterson AFB, Colorado; Vandenberg AFB, California; Columbus, Georgia; and on the Chitimacha Reservation in Charenton, Louisiana.
