Tiya Support Services Awarded Fort Benning DPW Contract

Baton Rouge, La. – July 17, 2010 - Tiya Support Services, LLC (“Tiya”) announced today that it has been awarded a contract to provide Base Operations Support Services for the Directorate of Public Works (“DPW”) at Fort Benning, Georgia. The DPW contract has a term of one base year plus four one year options for a total of five years and is valued at over \$118 million.

Tiya’s services under the DPW contract will support more than 120,000 active-duty military, family members, reserve component soldiers, retirees, and civilian employees on a daily basis. The installation consists of approximately 184,089 acres of ranges, courses, fields and roads; over 14 million square feet of buildings; 400,000 square feet of structures; and 950,000 square feet of surfaced area. Beginning in 2009 through 2011, the installation is anticipated to increase the personnel by approximately 40% and building and structures by 30% due to the Armor School’s transfer from Fort Knox to Fort Benning and the conversion of the U.S. Army Infantry Center to the Maneuver Center which combines infantry and armor training functions. This DPW contract will also be used for installation activities for Camp Merrill, Ga.; Camp Rudder, Fl.; Port Support Activity, Jacksonville, Fl.; and off post activities and units.

The DPW contract covers eleven different functional task areas: 1) work classification and management (standing operating orders, service orders, individual job orders, work reception, work documentation, work control); 2) buildings and structures maintenance; 3) dining facility equipment maintenance; 4) utility system operation and maintenance; 5) HVAC systems operation and maintenance; 6) grounds maintenance; 7) surfaced area maintenance; 8) material recycle facility operation and maintenance; 9) self help services; 10) remote camp operations, maintenance and support; and 11) range maintenance.

Tiya is a Louisiana business formed in 2004 by the Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana as a wholly owned subsidiary of Keta Group, LLC (“Keta”). The primary purpose of the Keta family of companies is to diversify and bolster the economy of the Chitimacha Tribe and provide opportunities and benefits to its members, approximately 1,000 people, by capitalizing on opportunities in the federal contracting market. The product and service offerings of the Keta Group family of companies are focused on disaster recovery services, space and defense engineering services, information technology services, construction, and facility management services associated with facility and base operations support. Keta’s corporate headquarters are located in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, and Keta has subsidiary and project offices in Colorado Springs, Colorado; Washington,

D.C.; Schriever AFB, Colorado; Peterson AFB, Colorado; Vandenberg AFB, California; Columbus, Georgia; and on the Chitimacha Reservation in Charenton, Louisiana.

Team subcontractor, Shaw Environmental and Infrastructure, is the incumbent Fort Benning DPW contractor and brings a wealth of knowledge and lessons learned to our Team and the contract. The Keta family of companies and Shaw Group have had a cooperative and successful working relationship since 2005.
